

Clerk's Report – January 2019

First of all – Happy New Year everyone.

The revised application for the boathouse at Fairhaven was approved.

As instructed at the last meeting, I have applied for the paperwork to add Cllr Honeywill to the list of bank signatories.

Several residents drew our attention to an apparent error in the draft Island Planning Strategy in the section on Local Green Spaces, where it appeared that the beach and foreshore had been indicated rather than the Lower Green. I contacted a Planning Officer who confirmed that they were aware of the error and it would be corrected. However, we were advised to note it in any submission that the Parish Council might make on the draft to ensure that it was dealt with. This led to a more general discussion as to the exact area that was designated as a village green and I will find out more information.

Cllr Honeywill and I will attend a training session on the draft Strategy at the end of January. I will also be attending the AGM/Annual Forum of the IW AoNB Partnership.

Otherwise it has been fairly quiet as I managed to have a few days' break over Christmas and New Year.
