

## **Clerks Report February 2020**

A number of updates this month:

Elenors Grove Notice Board – the planning permission consultation, for the repositioning, will go live on Friday (14<sup>th</sup>), with the end date of 6<sup>th</sup> March.

Unauthorised advertisement for Bellissimo opposite the end of Fishbourne Lane – this has been reported and IWC Planning enforcement will be asking for removal.

Website – I met Paul from Foundation Media regarding updating the website to meet the accessibility regulations. As you know the website is rather old and will need a complete overhaul. He will supply a quote in the near future so we can move this forward. I have obtained two other quotes ready to discuss at the March meeting.

Tree planting at Quarr – I've tried unsuccessfully to meet Matt at Quarr, the last time being Monday morning, so I'm going to send him over a proposal by email and go from there.

Bank signatory change – rumbling on.....'they have a backlog' is as much as I can get out of them

At the 11<sup>th</sup> Feb surgery two items were brought by a resident – moving a cycle way sign in Ashlake Copse Road – this request has been sent to IWC Rights of Way and a concealed entrance sign for Ashlake Copse Road onto Fishbourne Lane, this safety request has been sent to Island Roads.

Update - Unfortunately the request for the sign change was refused by Rights of Way.

Fishbourne Lane road markings – the hydro blasting machine will be on site on 17<sup>th</sup>/18<sup>th</sup> March and the lines repainted on 19<sup>th</sup>.
