

Chairman's Report – Fishbourne Parish Council 10th June 2021

Wightlink – Following last weekend I have attempted to get to meet Martin Gulliver before this meeting. At first this appeared to be quite possible but now that Martin realises the issue we have not yet agreed a date. I will be chasing him tomorrow.

I have also flagged this up with Bob Seely and I will be raising it with Ian Dore. Needless to say I am very disappointed that I have been unable to meet Martin before this meeting.

Boat dumped on the slipway – The notice period placed on the notice the Clerk put on the dinghy expires in a few days time. Subject to any decision at this evenings meeting I intend to arrange for the rubbish to be disposed of and the dinghy to be moved to the RVYC with a view to leasing it to a person or persons that will use it as a community asset.

Traffic on Fishbourne Lane – There are continuing problems with trailers being changed on the highway and other large vehicles parking in the Fishbourne Lane. We need to consider if there is a pattern in these activities and if so arrange for a parking warden to attend at the likely times.
