3. The Clerk reported that nothing had been received from the **Police** by way of an annual report.
4. **IWC Councillor Dore** was unable to attend but had sent a report which is attached to these minutes marked 'B'.

5. Open Session

Concern was raised over the mobile home parked on land adjacent to the copse on Kite Hill. The Chairman said the Parish Council were aware of the structure and had been assured that this was only used as an office and not as accommodation. However, this will continue to be monitored and action will be taken if any change occurs. Residents were urged to contact the Parish Council if they had any concerns regarding this or any other matter.

Speeding on Firestone Copse Road was highlighted, and the Chairman said this had been discussed in the past but the adjoining parish, Havenstreet and Ashe, were not in agreement regarding a change to the limit. It was noted that an island wide speed restriction survey will be undertaken by the IWC this year and as there will be local consultation, this may be the opportunity to address the issue.

Speeding was also highlight on the approach to Oaklands Close through to Quarr. PCSO will be contacted to request this area is monitored.
