

## **Chairman's Report – Fishbourne Parish Council 7<sup>th</sup> October 2021**

**Wightlink Bang Bang** – Progress is being made, the IW Council Public Health Department are monitoring the noise made by Victoria of Wight and Wightlink are being cajoled into taking action to resolve the problem. Monitoring continues.

**Traffic on Fishbourne Lane** - There were queues again last Sunday as one ferry was withdrawn from service. This was exacerbated by the information signs not working.

**Lorries parking waiting for their booked ferry journey** – I am pleased to report that the Clerks letters to various companies seem to be effective.

**Oak Tree Green** – I have had discussions with two residents on the question of the width restriction posts. One was moved by a resident to give a 6 foot six inch gap, but this caused a problem for another resident who then found it difficult to exit from their drive. Since these discussions I believe a vehicle has knocked over the post and Island roads have removed it and filled in the hole. It's a difficult issue – The restriction is required to prevent large vehicles from using the narrow side and knocking over posts and damaging the edge of the green, but the posts really need to be sited to suit all residents. I have arranged for the matter to be on the agenda
