### Dog Fouling Patrols.

### Found on foot/vehicle patrols.

- Reported in full/overflowing public waste bin at Bus stop to Island Roads for them to attend and clear.

- Small amounts of General litter along Fishbourne lane / Layby area from time to time, Cleansed by self.

-Island roads cleansing team have carried out litter picks from Kite hill, through Eleanor's grove including the layby to the entrance of Quarr Abbey.
